Snow College Economic Development and Workforce Preparation Advisory Committee

Review of Appointments
March 14, 2018

In accordance with *H.B. 340, and after a review of our current Economic Development and Workforce Preparation Advisory Committee members and their terms of service, it appears that it is time to make some adjustments to our appointees. Our review and recommendations are as follows:

1. Three representatives of business and industry whose term was met as follows:
 - Douglas Durfey from Data Discoveries - 2015
 - Jack Brady from Modular One - 2017
 - Brian Florang from LiquaDry – 2017
2. Current serving School District Superintendent from South Sanpete, Kent Larsen's term was met in 2015.

Therefore, at this time, our nominations for new four-year appointments are as follows:

1. Business and Industry
 - Glade Nielson from Lean Horizons, LLC – Nephi
 - Mark Alger from Ensign Staffing – Richfield
2. Serving School District Superintendent
 - Cade Douglas – Sevier School District

It is also our recommendation, in an attempt to continue to stagger appointment terms, that we extend the current appointments of committee members as follows:

1. Extend the term of service for the following business and industry employers an additional two years to 2020:
 - Brian Florang from LiquaDry - Abraham
 - Andrew Hill from ACT Aerospace – Gunnison
2. Additionally, extend our public education school district career and technical education director one more year to 2019.
 - Mark Anderson - North/South Sanpete and Juab School Districts

125 [(j) 10] (g) four representatives of business or industry employers within the region
 126 appointed by the [president of] Snow College Board of Trustees from nominations of the
 127 members appointed under Subsections (1)(a) through [(i).] (f);
 128 (h) one public education school district superintendent, appointed by the Snow College
 129 Board of Trustees, chosen from the school district superintendents serving in the Juab, Millard,
 130 Tintic, North Sanpete, South Sanpete, Wayne, Piute, and Sevier School Districts; and
 131 (i) one public education school district career and technical education director,
 132 appointed by the Snow College Board of Trustees, chosen from the career and technical
 133 education directors serving in the Juab, Millard, Tintic, North Sanpete, South Sanpete, Wayne,
 134 Piute, and Sevier School Districts.
 135 (2) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (2)(b), a member of the Snow College
 136 Economic Development and Workforce Preparation Advisory Committee shall serve for a term
 137 of four years. 138 (b) The president of Snow College shall adjust the length of the terms to ensure
 that the
 139 terms of committee members are staggered so that approximately half of the committee
 140 members are appointed every two years.
