Welcome to [Snow College's AS in Nursing!](#) Snow College's AS in Nursing is accredited by the [Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing, Inc. \(ACEN\)](#) and the [Utah State Board of Nursing \(UBON\)](#). Snow College's nursing program enables students to apply for and take the [National Council Licensure Examination \(NCLEX-RN\)](#). Snow College is accredited by the [Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities \(NWCCU\)](#).

Because nursing requires licensure, it is recommended that all students are familiar with the requirements posted on the [Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing \(DOPL\)](#) or similar agencies within the state of interest. The Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing (DOPL) can be reached at 801-530-6628 or via their website (linked above).

The [Nurse Licensure Compact \(NLC\)](#) allows licensed nurses who reside in a state that participates in NLC to have licensure in other states that participate. Utah is a participating state. A full map of participating states is available at the Nurse Licensure Compact website.

Each state has set their own standards for licensure that are independent of graduating from Snow College. States may require additional course work or professional training. Below is contact information for licensing boards for US States and Territories. Snow College does not monitor the licensing requirements for non-US States and Territories.
